ASPECTS OF MT BARKER

Enjoy a day experiencing a mix of wines and history of the Mt Barker region..

Begin your day with a visit to Galafrey wines—a purely dry grown vineyard. After leaving Galafrey's we visit the Mt Barker Museum housed in the old Police Station for a reflection on the tools, machinery and everyday items used in the early years of the region. Lunch today is enjoyed in the beautiful surrounds of Windrush Wines with your hosts John and Jan. After lunch we visit St Werburgh's Chapel built in 1873 from pug and clay from a nearby hole. To complete our day we pay a visit to the picturesque West Cape Howe Winery enjoying their elegant range of wines.
